

List of Examples of Qatar investments in Sudan

- Qatari investments in Sudan represent a large proportion of foreign investment there. Total Qatari investments amount to approximately \$ 4 billion, according to figures from the Sudanese Ministry of Investment.
- Qatar and Sudan signed a mid-2018 agreement worth \$ 4 billion to develop the port of Swakin on the Red Sea.
- A maritime transport line will be inaugurated between Hamad Port and Sawakin Port and all Sudanese ports on the Red Sea.
- The agricultural project of the Qatari company, Hassad, is the most prominent. The company contributes to the cultivation of 260 thousand feddans (110 thousand hectares) in the state of the River Nile.
- Hassad is implementing an electricity project for the region at an estimated cost of more than \$ 200 million
- Wadam Qatari Food and Poultry Projects
- Qatari Diar projects in the field of investment and real estate development in Khartoum North, which includes educational institutions, health facilities and luxury hotels
- Qatar National Investment Bank's projects in the field of banking and banking development in Sudan, where the bank has 14 branches
- Qatar Metal Projects, which invests in the Sudanese Ministry of Metals in seven squares for exploration of metals and gold
- Barwa's investment in infrastructure development in Sudan
- Strategic relations are not limited to the economic side only, but Qatar has provided huge amounts for archaeological missions to develop the effects of Nubia in Sudan
- Museums have also provided financial and technical support to preserve the Sudanese archaeological sites and provide support to provide the latest technology available and develop the skills of Sudanese academic institutions
- In the field of humanitarian action, Qatari institutions, led by the Qatar Development Fund (QFD), have provided substantial material support to the development of development projects in Sudan

- In addition to significant support of more than \$ 70 million in the framework of the Qatar Initiative for the Development of Darfur, and supporting public benefit projects from schools, hospitals, clinics and educational structures to empower the people of Darfur
- The Qatari Red Crescent and Qatar Charity have provided very significant assistance in the construction of drinking water plants, electricity networks, solar-powered projects, houses and schools, green spaces and the construction of model residential complexes
- Qatar launched an initiative to build 10 complete villages, five integrated housing compounds in Darfur, and provided more than \$ 90 million under the projects of the United Nations Development Fund in Darfur
- Qatar contributed more than \$ 180 million to the donor conference held in Doha in 2013 to support reconstruction in Darfur
- National development institutions, especially the Silatech Foundation, have launched an entrepreneurship project to boost the proportion of Sudanese youth funding and establish a youth project lending fund.
- Silatech established a fund to support university graduates, create job opportunities for them, and employ them, as well as help them start or develop their own projects
- Silatech launched the "Hope Program" to support the Sudanese government in rehabilitating and integrating Sudanese youth who were previously caught in the trap of terrorism and extremism, and providing material and moral support to them to become productive members of society.
- Silatech has launched the Sama Youth Program to expand start-up microfinance programs in Sudan
- In addition to all the above, the country's pivotal role in achieving peace and enhancing security and stability in Sudan / the Doha peace document
- Qatar also provided \$ 20 million to the African Union for victims of irregular migration and human trafficking, which will be used to support microfinance programs to assist in the reintegration of returnees in their countries of origin
